This Sunday's second reading, James 5:1-6, is going to challenge us. St. James does not expect every one of us to give up everything we have, sell it, give it to the poor and become followers of Jesus. He is not expecting us to leave our family, friends, job and life, and go everywhere to preach the word of God, St. James only wants us to be aware and avoid greed in every form, and that we are willing to share our wealth with those who are in need.

Pope Paul VI in his encyclical letter, *Populorum Progressio*, in which he spoke about wealth and poverty, cited what St. Ambrose said about charity: "You are not making a gift of your possessions to poor persons. You are handing over to them what is theirs. For what has been given in common for the use of all, you have arrogated to yourself. The world is given to all, and not only to the rich."

This weekend, Sister Helen Marie Miksch, from the Sisters Congregation of Divine Providence of San Antonio, will speak to us about her ministry and her work. Let us listen to Sister Helen and learn how we can help, share, and give to her pastoral ministry.

**Liturgy notes** ~ During the month of September we will be introducing a new mass setting at the English masses. The term “mass setting” refers to the peoples’ sung parts of the mass. The mass is called Holy Name of Jesus Mass by Norah Duncan IV. We are already singing the Glory to God from this mass. As you learn the other mass parts you will notice strains of melodies from the Glory to God incorporated in the rest of the mass. We will introduce the mass slowly i.e., the Holy, Holy for a couple of weeks then introduce the Memorial Acclamation etc. Since the new translation of the mass in 2010 we have the option of three Memorial Acclamations.

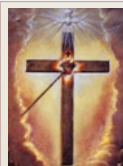
